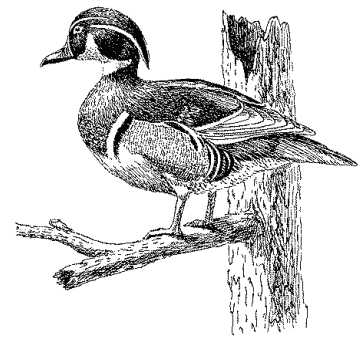
The Board of Directors has met several times to handle club business. We continue our search for training

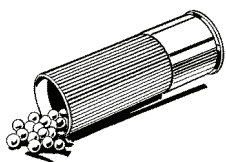
